*John 18:1-12*

*Introduction:*

### **1. The Prophetic Setting**

*“Jesus...went out with His disciples across the Kidron Valley where there was a garden which He and His disciples entered” (1)*

*“they went to the Mount of Olives...to a place called Gethsemane” (Mark 14:26, 32)*

*“While all the country was weeping with a loud voice...The King passed over the brook Kidron” (2 Samuel 15:23)*

*God drove Adam out...of the garden” (Genesis 3:24)*

### **2. The Apostate Sinners**

*“Judas, having procured a band of soldiers and some officers from the chief priests and the Pharisees, went there with lanterns and torches and weapons” (3)*

*“and the elders of the people” (Matthew 26:47)*

*“the band of soldiers and their Captain [Commander/Chiliarch]” (12)*

*“the hour has come. The Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners” (Mark 14:41)*

*“My betrayer is at hand” (Matthew 26:46)*

*“My close friend in whom I trusted, who ate My bread, has lifted up his heel against Me” (Psalm 41:9)*

*“they weighed out thirty shekels of silver as my wages” (Zechariah 11:12)*

### 3. **The Majestic Savior**

*“Jesus, knowing all that would happen to Him, came forward...” (4)*

*“When Jesus said to them, ‘I AM,’ they drew back and fell to the ground” (6)*

*“one of them struck the servant of the high priest and cut off his right ear. But Jesus said, ‘No more of this!’ And He touched his ear and He healed him” (Luke 22:50-51)*

*“And Jesus said to them...‘let the Scriptures be fulfilled’ ” (Mark 14:48-49)*

*“Then they arrested Him and led Him away” (Luke 22:54)*
